TYPE OF PROGRAMME

The programme duration is 3 years on a full-time basis, or 5 years on a part-time basis. Tuition is face to face and is scheduled per campus. Programmes are offered during the week on a full-time and part-time basis. Part-time tuition is scheduled as per the stipulated planner.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants wishing to enrol for the Diploma in Hospitality Management are required to meet the following minimum entry requirements:

National Senior Certificate (NSC):

with a diploma endorsement, and

English (home language) or English (1st additional language): a minimum rating of 4, and

OR

Senior Certificate:

a minimum symbol of E for English on the higher grade, or D for English on the standard grade, and

OR

National Certificate (Vocational):

a minimum of 40% for Communication or English, and vocational subjects relevant to hospitality/catering.



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LEARNER MATERIAL

Prescribed textbook lists will be provided by the academic department at your campus. Students will receive electronic versions of the study guides for this programme.

PRICING

ADDITIONAL COSTS

EXAMINATION AUTHORITY

All Examinations are set by Berea College of Technology.

CERTIFICATION

On successful completion of the programme, the student will receive a Berea College of Technology Diploma in Hospitality Management.

ARTICULATION

The Diploma allows for horizontal as well as vertical articulation with other institutions which may present similar qualifications, both nationally and international.

Vertical articulation:

This qualification may articulate vertically with any relevant cognate qualification at NQF Level 7. (for example Advanced Diploma in Hospitality Management currently in conceptualization stage)

Horizontal articulation:

This qualification may articulate horizontally with any relevant cognate qualification at NQF Level 6. (for example Diplomas offered at public and private Higher Education providers).

This qualification may articulate diagonally to other qualifications at NQF Level 7. (for example Bachelor's degrees and Advanced Diplomas in education, management, catering and tourism offered at public and private Higher Education providers).
